INTENT

This scholarship is for first-time college students and/or for those who have been out of college for 3 years or more, to cover the cost of one initial 3-credit class including tuition, fees and books while at University College at Rockland. This scholarship will provide important access to higher education for local residents of mid-coast Maine.

ELIGIBILITY

1. The applicant will demonstrate a high degree of motivation.
2. The applicant will have graduated high school more than three years ago.
3. The applicant will have stated financial need.
4. The applicant will be a first-time college student OR be out of college for 3 years or more.
5. The applicant must be a Maine high school graduate or Maine HiSET (GED) recipient.

APPLICATION MATERIALS

Applicants will submit the following:

A one-page essay including the student's name, address, phone contact, date of birth, a summary of the student's educational past, reasons for pursuing college, and the need for outside financial support.

A letter of reference from a non-family member.

SELECTION PROCESS

Applicants will be reviewed and selected by the scholarship committee of University College at Rockland. A one-time scholarship will be awarded each fall and spring term.
